## Pay now or (really) pay later

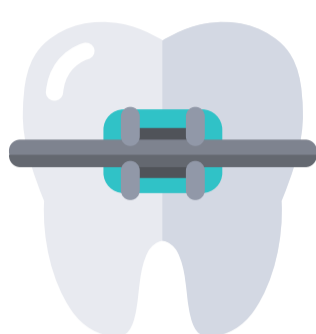
Let's face it, sometimes these expensive treatments are necessary. Especially if they will prevent the need for further and more extensive dental work down the road.

## Braces

\$3,000 - \$10,000



## Gum disease treatment

Cause: Formation of bacteria from crooked teeth  
**\$350 - \$10,000**

## Veneers

Cause: Worn teeth from misalignment  
**\$500 - \$1,900 (per tooth)**

## Crowns

Cause: Protruding teeth cracked or chipped  
**\$500 - \$3,000 (per tooth)**

## Veneers

\$500 - \$1,900 (per tooth)



## Crowns

Cause: Worn teeth could eventually crack  
**\$500 - \$3,000 (per tooth)**

## Braces

Cause: Minor misalignment grows worse  
**\$3000 - \$10,000**

## Bridges

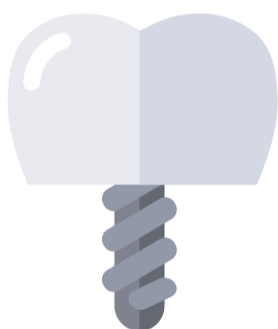
Cause: Deterioration leading to tooth loss  
**\$500 - \$1,200 (per pontic)**

## Dentures

Cause: Deterioration leading to major tooth loss  
**\$300 - \$30,000 (per plate)**

## Crowns

\$500 - \$3,000 (per tooth)



## Bridges

Cause: Deterioration leading to tooth loss  
**\$500 - \$1,200 (per pontic)**

## Dentures

Cause: Deterioration leading to major tooth loss  
**\$300 - \$30,000 (per plate)**

## Bridges

\$500 - \$1,200 (per pontic)



## Braces

Cause: Missing tooth results in teeth mobility  
**\$3,000 - \$10,000**

## Bone Graft

Cause: Missing tooth results in bone resorption  
**\$2,000 - \$3,000 (per implant site)**

## Dentures

\$300 - \$30,000 (per plate)



## Gum disease treatment

Cause: Infected gums from damaged teeth  
**\$350 - \$10,000**

## Continued complications:

- Extra-sensitive teeth
- Bone resorption
- Indigestion from improper chewing
- Gum disease linked to heart disease
